- Please state clearly if NOT prepared to compete in a higher status/age group. Status changes must be notified before the draw.
- All doubling must be notified with the entry. This includes all sharing of CREW MEMBERS & BOATS. The committee may refuse doubled entries at the time of the draw. No entry fee for coxes.
- Masters events will be run under the handicap system EXCEPT the Masters Novice Events.
- Competitors must be able to produce their British Rowing membership licence. Failure to do this will result in a trophy/prize being withheld.
